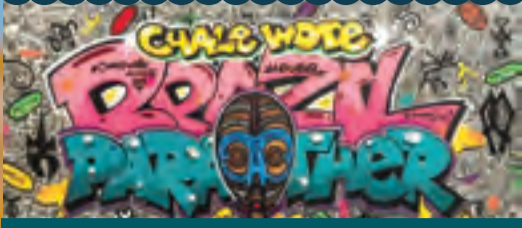


MCI CHALE WOTE FESTIVAL TOURS

Proof of Yellow Fever is required

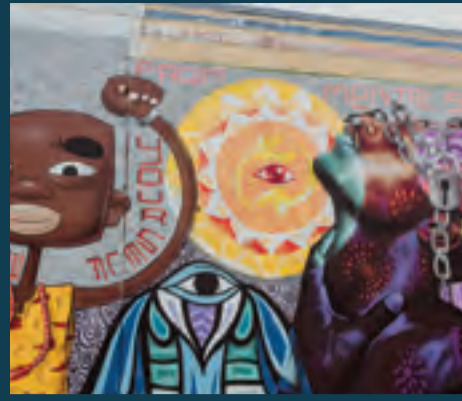
